



PINGRUP TOWN STANDPIPE SWIPE CARD SYSTEM START DATE: 15 JUNE 2020

A new swipe card system has been installed at the standpipe (purple tanks) located at Paterson Street in Pingrup (opposite the Pingrup Depot) and will become fully operational as of Monday 15 June 2020.

The swipe card system allows more efficiency and accuracy in water billing and will assist the shire to better manage the water supply point.

In order to acquire water from this standpipe **all customers must register** with the Shire of Kent to be issued with a swipe card. Only one swipe card per customer will be provided free of charge. Any additional or replacement swipe cards required will be provided at a cost of \$25 per card.

A registration form must be completed and returned to the admin office prior to swipe cards being ready for customers to collect and activation. Details provided must include:

- Name of Individual or Company
- Contact Name
- Address for billing
- Email address
- Contact phone number

Registration forms for swipe cards are available by contacting the administration office on 9829 1051, or by visiting the Shire of Kent website, and can either be returned to the office in person, by post or emailed to dceo@kent.wa.gov.au

To further assist customers with the issuing of swipe cards prior to the operational date of 15 June 2020, Deputy CEO, Michelle Bamess, will be at the **Pingrup CRC** to register, issue and activate swipe cards on:

- **Tuesday 9 June 2020 from 1.00pm – 3.00pm and**
- **Thursday 11 June 2020 from 10.00am – 12.00pm.**

You can either come in and complete a registration form at that time or bring in completed forms for processing and activation. Swipe cards will also be available for collection by customers who register prior to these dates, unless a prior arrangement for collection has been made.
