



SHIRE OF KENT REFUSE SITES – NYABING AND PINGRUP

FOR SHIRE RESIDENTS ONLY

ACCESS SWIPE CARD SYSTEM

As part of the shire’s plan to extend the life of our landfill refuse sites and to meet Department Water & Environmental Regulations (DWER) an automatic gate system with CCTV has been installed. To ensure convenience to the Shire of Kent community you are able to access these sites using new access swipe cards.

<i>Do I need a card to access refuse sites and where can I get one?</i>	Yes, your card will access both sites and can be picked up anytime from Shire Administration Office 24-26 Richmond St, Nyabing during business hours.	
<i>Who gets a card?</i>	One access card per ratepayer will be provided. Extra cards may be issued to additional <i>occupied</i> households under a single Rates Assessment Number. Each additional card requires another form.	
<i>What do I need to do?</i>	A registration form must be completed and returned to the shire office prior to access cards being issued and must be signed for upon collection. Cards will not be posted.	
<i>Where do I get the application form for a card?</i>	Registration forms can be completed at time of card collection, but the forms are also available on the Shire Website , or by contacting the shire office via admin@kent.wa.gov.au . Forms can be returned to the office in person, by post, or by email to dceo@kent.wa.gov.au . Note: card must be collected in person at the Shire Office.	
<i>Can I take anything to my local landfill site?</i>	No, due to limited capacity the Nyabing Site and Pingrup Transfer station should mainly be used for domestic rubbish. Items such as chemicals, cooking/waste oil, paint, fuel, LPG gas cylinders, large truck tyres, tractor and large machinery tyres, asbestos, chemical drums, shuttles, hazardous waste and septage are not accepted at either the Nyabing or Pingrup refuse sites.
