Re: Proposal for the use of Nyabing Go Kart Track for Grass Roots Motorsport Event

Great Southern Street Machine Association Inc. would like to host a grass roots motorsport event at the Nyabing Go Kart Track. The event we are hoping to host will be a Drifting test and tune, demonstration, introduction to drifting event. Drifting is a driver technique where the driver intentionally oversteers, while maintaining control and driving the car through the entirety of the corner. As well as a motorkhana which will include a Go to Whoa, cruise the track and if time permits another test. Motorkhana is regarded as the introductory level of events in the spectrum of motorsport. They offer to Clubs and Competitor the opportunity to conduct and take part in some of the less formalised events conducted under the National Competition Rules, in which the essential skills of car control and judgement may be practised under controlled conditions. The event itself would be hosted over a two-day period being a Saturday and Sunday. The event will be insured and governed by the rules and regulations of Australian Auto Sport Alliance (AASA) our sanctioning body.

Great Southern Street Machine Association Inc. (GSSMA Inc.) was established over thirty-five years ago. Our membership is over a hundred members, who have a passion for all things automotive. Grass roots Motorsport competition has been a large part of our Club for majority of our thirty-five years. Annually we host two rounds of WA Speed Event Series, Albany Wind Farm Hill Climb and the Pendeen Sprint. These events have been held for the past 10 years. Our annual Show & Shine which we hold a motorkhana event. Our Show & Shine has been running for 26 years. Past events have included Mt. Clarence Hill Climb, burn out competition at the local speedway, 1/8-mile straight line sprint for an Esperance club, street sprint for Racewars. We also provide volunteers and officials for events, Albany around the houses, Targa West events, Collie MotorPlex events. We have a very diverse membership with younger members joining and bring different motoring interests. Drifting is a relatively new discipline, which several of our younger members are involved in. The Nyabing Go Kart Track is a perfect place for them to test and tune their cats as well as introduce the discipline to other members and your community.

Insurance

Sanctioning Body AASA- The AASA is happy to support and sanction your proposed events at Nyabing Go Kart Track. As previously discussed, all safety can be complied with via our Standing Regulations with regard with to your proposed Motorkhana, Go to Whoa and Drift events.

Permit- A permit is a certificate issued by AASA which officially sanctions an event and enables the insured to be covered under AASA insurance program with respect to the activities associated with the sanctioned event.

Public Liability- Cover for the Insured for their legally liable to pay compensation in respect of Personal Injury or Property Damage as a result of an incident occurring in connection with the business of the insured. \$25,000,000 in one Occurrence

Participant Liability- Cover for the Insured in respect for their legal liability to another Insured arising from the participation in an Insured event. \$5,000,00 in one occurrence

Professional Liability- Cover for the Insured whereby they are legally liable to pay damages, claimant costs, and expenses in respect of any claim arising as a direct result of any negligent act, error, or omission in the conduct of the Insurer's business. \$1,000,000 in any one incident and \$2,000,000 over the fully policy period

Personal Accident/Injury- Cover applies whilst the insured person is engaged in a sanctioned event.
