If a pass is lost or damaged, please contact the Shire of Kent.

Replacement tags will incur a **\$25** fee

Pingrup

- All household waste is to be placed into the skip bin in the transfer station shed.
- There is a second skip bin for metals.
- The green waste area is behind the transfer station shed.
- There is an allocated area for disposing of whitegoods behind the transfer station shed.

- Cars can be accepted, a fee of **\$1,100.00** per car body will apply.
- Putrescible waste (dead stock/offal) can be accepted by appointment only - a fee of **\$77** will apply.

Fines Apply for Illegal Dumping
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Both Sites

- Oil waste facilities are available - Please Note: empty drums and take them with you; if drums are left behind this is considered illegal dumping and fines will apply
- When placing Green (garden) Waste in refuse sites, please ensure not to include any plastics, this creates noxious fumes when there is a burn off.
- Metals should be free of contaminants such as plastic, rubber, timber, concrete etc.

Please be aware that both sites are monitored via CCTV and if seen illegal dumping, fines will apply.
